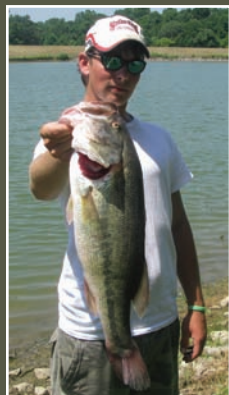

LARGE BASS

Welcome to the 2010 Fyrne Lake Newsletter. Our purpose is to update you on our efforts to constantly improve your fishing and boating experience at Fyrne Lake.

In 2009, for the third year in a row, we stocked Fyrne Lake with black crappie to join the already established white crappie and large mouth bass populations. We also stocked our black crappie breeder pond and confirmed successful reproduction. This spring, we'll start regularly transferring crappie from the pond into our main lake.

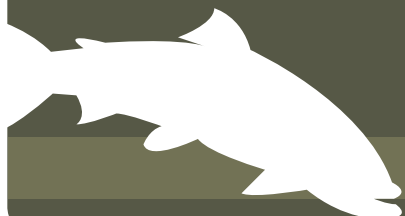
We've made tremendous progress in reducing the small bass population. **THANK YOU!** With your help, we have removed thousands of 12" and smaller large mouth bass and stripes. One of our longtime members, Otha Lewis, has removed over 3000 in 2009 alone! With your and Otha's help, we have concentrated the baitfish food supply to produce keeper crappie and lunker bass!

Speaking of the baitfish population, our earlier efforts at establishing shiner and fathead minnow populations have been successful. Schools of minnows are commonly observed along the shoreline and shiners have been frequently captured during lake sampling. Threadfin shad has also been established with schools frequently encountered by fisherman in open water. We'll continue to supplement the population with additional stocking this spring.

In 2009, we planted 500 cypress trees, 300 lily pads and hundreds of pickerel weed plants along the shoreline to provide habitat for baitfish and game fish fry and to reduce shoreline erosion. 200 of the cypress trees were fitted with tube protectors and many of the lily pads and pickerel weed plants were covered with cages to reduce their vulnerability to plant eating mammals, turtles and fish.

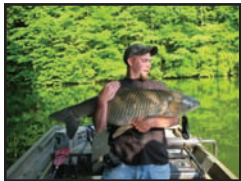

We've purchased hundreds of Bill Dance porcupine fish attractor globes for you to create your own honey hole! Each globe will accept 26 individual pieces of 1/2" PVC pipe. Roland is ready to train you on their assembly and lake placement to obtain the best results. All you'll need to bring is the pipe. We'll provide the globes, the glue and a place to assemble.
